



ANHEUSER-BUSCH AND SILVER EAGLE HOUSTON PROVIDE EMERGENCY DRINKING WATER AFTER WINTER STORM

HOUSTON, TX (February 20, 2021) – Anheuser-Busch and Silver Eagle Distributors Houston, LLC are providing 35,280 cans of emergency drinking water to aid in relief efforts from winter weather that recently impacted the Houston-area.

“While Houston may be a stranger to below freezing temperatures and winter weather, we are no stranger on understanding the importance of giving back to our communities during times of hardship and uncertainty,” said John Johnson, president of Silver Eagle Houston. “We’re honored to be an Anheuser-Busch wholesaler and be able to provide water through Anheuser-Busch’s emergency drinking water program to the City of Houston.”

“The City of Houston is grateful to Anheuser-Busch and Silver Eagle for providing emergency drinking water during this challenging time. Many of our families are living without electricity or clean drinking water as a direct result of the historic freezing weather that blanketed the region earlier this week and damaged infrastructure. The water donation is another sign of Houston’s cooperative spirit. As a city, we are strong and resilient. We will get through this together,” said Mayor Sylvester Turner.

The canned water is expected to arrive on Saturday, February 20, 2021, in Houston, Texas, where Silver Eagle Houston will work with the City of Houston to distribute the water to those in need.

The water will be sourced from Anheuser-Busch’s brewery in Cartersville, Georgia, and Fort Collins, Colorado, which periodically pauses beer production to can drinking water to help communities in times of disaster.

Anheuser-Busch has a longstanding tradition of providing emergency drinking water and supplies for disaster relief efforts dating back to 1906. Since 1988, Anheuser-Busch and their wholesaler partners, including Silver Eagle Houston, have provided more than 86 million cans of water to U.S. communities affected by natural disasters and other crises nationwide.
