1. Statistics show that 80 percent of all crashes and 65 percent of near crashes involve some type of distraction.
2. Drivers using cell phones, handheld or blue tooth, are 4 times as likely to get into crashes serious enough to injure themselves.
3. Using a cell phone (handheld or hands free) while driving delays a driver's reactions as much as having a blood alcohol concentration of .08 percent.
4. If you need to make or take a call while driving
 - a. Check your surroundings and try to maintain safe distance from vehicle ahead
 - b. Pull off the road into a parking lot or other safe place away from other drivers
